_____ **ME Transfer Student Award**

- Presented to a student who transfers from a non-UM institution and demonstrates a meaningful motivation for transferring to Michigan.
- Need 1 or more letters of support (not necessarily from U of M)

_____ **ME Outstanding Service Award**

- Presented to a student who has demonstrated a strong commitment to service (i.e., service outside of society activities or beyond that required by student societies).
- Include 1 or 2 letter(s) of recommendation from someone involved in your service (preferably someone in a supervisory role)

_____ **ME Impact Award**

- Presented to a sophomore or junior who has made a significant contribution to mechanical engineering through, e.g., research, society involvement, or industry.
- Include 1 or 2 letter(s) of recommendation from someone who is knowledgeable about your contribution

_____ **ME Future Leader Award**

- Presented to a senior who has traveled down a unique path to cultivate their passion. This experience should empower the individual to become a future leader in mechanical engineering.
- Include 2 letters of recommendation from someone familiar with your experiences and future plans (at least 1 needs to be an academic reference)
